

DALMENY PS IS A NUT AWARE SCHOOL



At Dalmeny Public School our aim is to provide a safe learning environment for all people in our school community. To support this, we advise our community that we do not have a full ban on nut products but are a 'Nut Aware School'. This aims to increase our school community awareness of nut allergies and to minimise the risks to students, staff, volunteers and visitors with documented allergies to nut products.

WHY is this important? Anaphylaxis is a severe form of potentially life-threatening allergic reaction and peanuts and tree nuts are among the most common causes. The best way to prevent anaphylaxis is to stay away from substances that cause this severe reaction. Management is via immediate injection of adrenaline with follow up emergency transfer to hospital.

Knowing this, we encourage parents, children and staff to avoid bringing foods that contain nuts to school. Products that contain, or may have nuts as an ingredient, include:

- Nuts
- Peanut butter
- Nut spreads such as Nutella
- Most fruit bars, nut bars and muesli bars
- Some biscuits
- Chocolates and any other products that have nuts listed in the ingredients

Our school acknowledges that it is impractical to ask parents not to send foods that state 'may contain traces of nuts' on the label. This Nut Aware Policy applies to those ingredients specifically listed on the product label.

SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES:

At Dalmeny Public School we will -

- Reinforce appropriate avoidance and management strategies.
- Keep updated Health Care Plan information and a photo of students with a diagnosis of anaphylaxis in classrooms, the canteen and the first aid room.
- Where individual health care plans are supplied, notification will be sent home to these classes where individual adjustments are required.
- Ensure that the canteen and other school lunch providers are aware of the Nut Aware status and comply with this.
- Ensure that any food items donated for school events such as Sports Day, fundraising events, etc., are labelled with 'this product may contain nuts.

Enrol now for kindergarten 2025

This year is flying by and we will be welcoming kinder 2025 before we know it! If you have a child/ren who is ready to commence school in 2025 our school office is ready for enrolments. To enrol please use the online enrolment form and gather your ID documents to ensure proof of residency, for example, as we can only enrol our local students.https://dalmeny-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/about-our-school/enrolment.html.

If you're unsure if your child is of school age for 2025, please check the details below. We also encourage you to speak with your current preschool/day care provider about your child's transition to school.

When can my child start kindergarten?

Your child can start kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five on or before 31 July in that year. By law, all children must be enrolled in school by their sixth birthday.

Students starting kindergarten in 2025 are born on or between 01/08/2019 and 31/07/2020.

Is your Kindergarten 2025 child enrolled?

If so, our Transition to School Sessions commence on Tuesday 6th August.

Enrolments

The NSW Department of Education has defined local area enrolment zones and encourages all students to attend their local school.

In NSW we have 'School Finder' to support the community in finding their local school. This can be accessed through: School Finder (nsw.gov.au)

- Prospective enrolment applications to Dalmeny Public School may be submitted online. https://education.nsw.gov.au/content/dam/main-education/public-schools/going-to-a-public-school/media/documents/enrol-k12.pdf
- 100 points of evidence of in area residence is required for all applications.

While families may submit an out of area application, it is important that applicants for out of area submissions understand that all NSW Public Schools have an enrolment cap. Schools may accept enrolments from outside of their designated intake area only if places are available. To have places available the school's actual student numbers must be lower than the enrolment cap.

The Secretary of the NSW Department of Education has identified a **capped enrolment of 555** students for Dalmeny Public School. Our current enrolment numbers are significantly above our enrolment cap.

This means Dalmeny is not able to offer enrolments to students who reside out of the school intake area.

Canteen – Fresh Start Canteen

Fresh Start Canteens is our onsite canteen. Food is prepared daily for students' breakfast, lunch and snacks.

Canteen orders may be ordered:

- on line through the online app "flexischools' <u>Flexischools: Australia's #1 School Canteen Online</u>
 Ordering App
- at school. Your child will need to order using a paper bag, clearly marked with their name, class and
 whether it is for Break 1 or Break 2. Please take to the canteen on arrival at school. Payment is to be
 included securely in the bag.

Students have time to make purchases from the canteen during Break 1 and Break 2

Administration of prescribed medications and healthcare procedures

Parents of children who require prescribed medication to be administered at school must complete a written request which is available from the office. This medication will need to be kept safe at the office.

Students must not carry medications unless there is a written agreement between the school and the student's parents that this a planned part of the student's health care support. Students suffering from asthma may carry their medication with them and, as part of their health care plan should be educated in the use of that medication.

Non Prescribed Medications

Schools are not permitted to administer medication that has not been prescribed by a medical practitioner. Parents are asked to **not send** Panadol/Cold & Flu medications if they have not been issued to students via a prescription form a doctor. Permission to administer will be required in these instances – please contact the office for a copy of the appropriate paperwork.

School Bytes

Our community should all now be aware that we are using School Bytes to email information to specific grades and/or groups of students – we use this in conjunction with Audiri. Excursion and other permission notes are being sent electronically, with links to online payment included in the electronic communication.



Please download the App to give you all the benefits that School Bytes offers. If you have multiple children enrolled with us, we recommend that you sign up for the School Bytes parent portal to enable you to view permissions and transactions for all your children in one place.

We ask that you please:
