As a reader, understanding the author's purpose helps you thoroughly understand the content. As a writer, establishing your purpose helps to create structure and identify both direct and subtle ways to reveal your message.

3. Do you agree with the author's opinion? Why or why not?

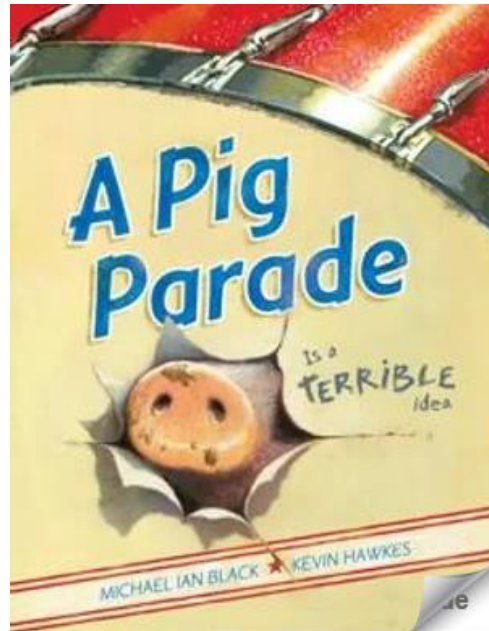

Synonyms are **words that are similar to another word or have a related meaning**. For example, the words **begin, start, commence, and initiate** are all synonyms of one another.

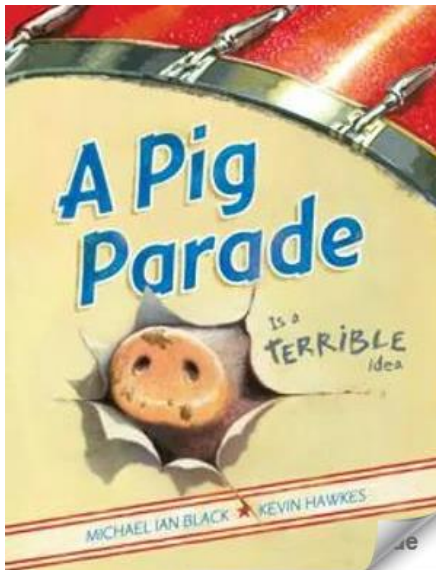

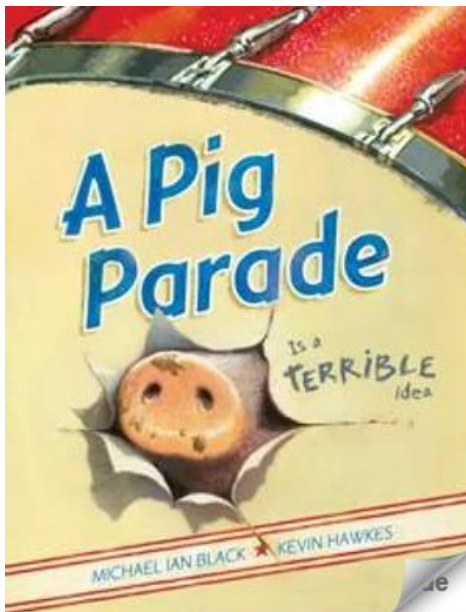
