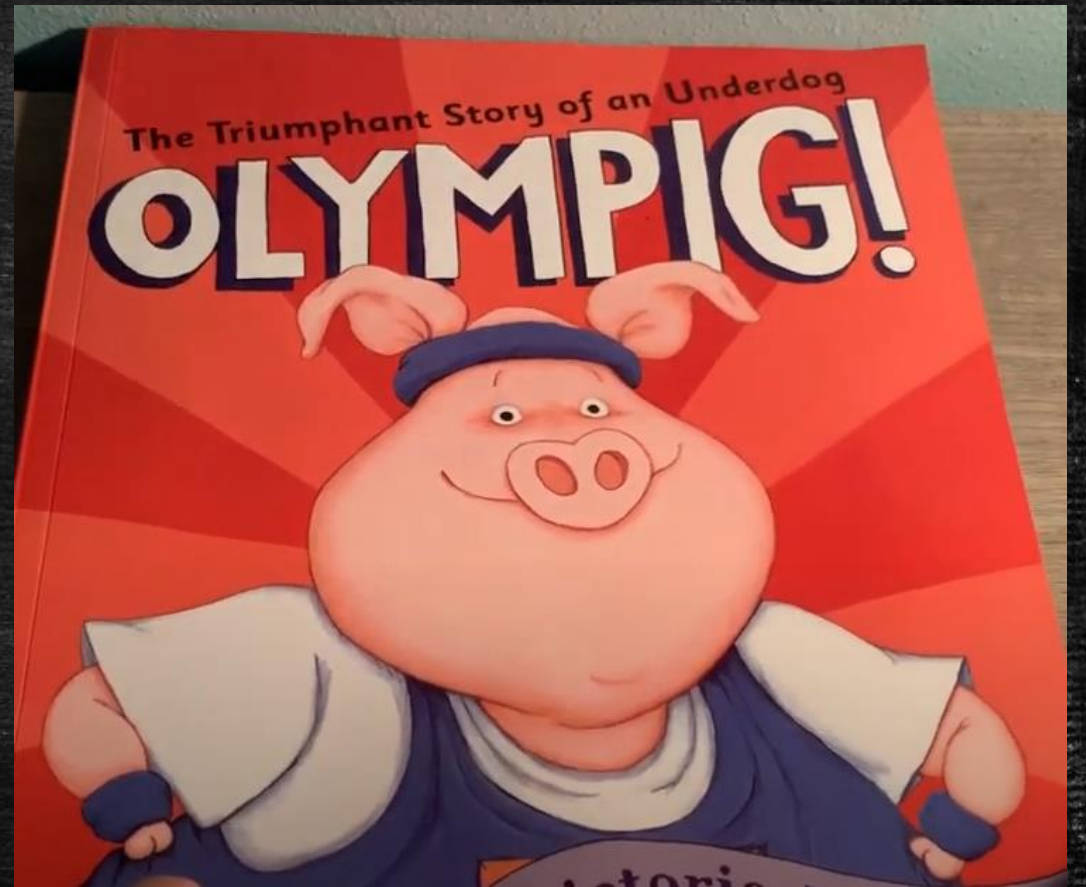
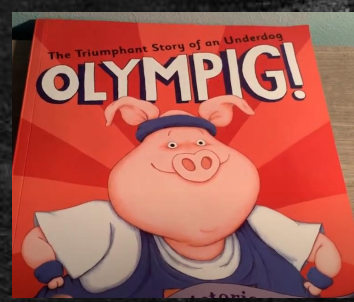


# Olympig

- Throughout the story there are a lot of adjectives.

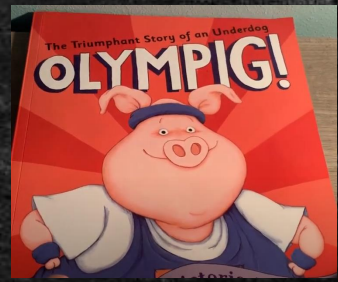

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### Characteristics of an Olympic Champion

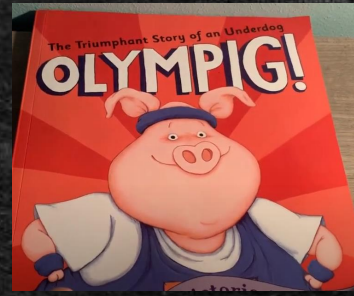


The story talks about the pig Boomer and what characteristics will make him a good athlete. For example: a hard worker.

Make a list of the 6 sports.

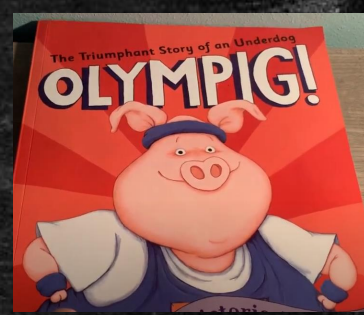
Have you ever competed in any of these sports? Which one?
