2013 END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES

KINDERGARTEN FUN DAY: Wednesday, 11 December 2013

Kindergarten students will participate in cookie decorating, crazy hairspray, afternoon movie viewing and also tackle the inflatable "Backyard Obstacle Challenge" course and jumping castle. A sausage sizzle lunch will be offered. A packet of chips, a drink and an ice-block will aslo be provided on the day. Children are asked to bring a small treat to eat during the afternoon movie session. The cost to students is \$15 each which covers all activities. In the afternoon, students will view a movie. Students will need to provide their own lunch but will be provided with chips and a drink while viewing the movie. They will aslo have the opportunity to create their own ice-cream sundae using a variety of toppings. Students must bring packed recess and lunch from home and wear full school sport uniform including enclosed shoes and a school hat. Please also bring a change of clothes, shoes and a towel. The cost is \$12. Permission note and payment must be returned by Wednesday, 11 December.

SUPPORT UNIT FUN DAY: Tuesday, 10 December 2013
