#### **End of Year Calendar & Payments**

It is imperative that you download our school app, as last minutes reminders and changes to routine are advertised via push notifications sent directly to your device.

A key aspect of this is keeping track of when payments are due for excursions and fun days as late payments cannot be accepted. As I explained to parents at last Monday's assembly, a new state-wide system has replaced school-based bank accounts with a central payment process.

We request payment through the Department's Finance Directorate meaning numbers must be finalised so that payment can be forwarded to excursion providers by the due date.

In addition, many centres require final student numbers leading up to the actual excursion, so last minute additions cannot be accommodated.

In summary, **please** ensure payments are made by the due date to avoid disappointment.
