PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Families and Friends.

Term 3 interviews are completed and I would like to thank teachers, students and parents for such positive and valuable input into the process. Every teacher I have spoken to have been so grateful for their students and parents and the time shared together. Our only concern is the weather for our families waiting for their interviews times. Time is a challenge in many ways. Staff will review interviews and implementation. The school will seek parent and student input into the process during Term 4.

Thank you to all the parents who are working with the school executive to improve the safety of students waiting for parent pick up from the 'Kiss and Drop' zone on Dalmeny Drive.

Please be aware that the council rangers and police timetable visits across all schools in our area that have 'Kiss and Drop' zones operating. Rangers will fine any drivers not complying with 'Kiss and

Drop' regulations and police will fine any driver not complying with road rules and 'Kiss and Drop' regulations.

Cars coming into the zone must move as far ahead as possible, once the car has stopped students will walk to the car. We ask that students open the car doors on the footpath side.

It is not safe for children to put their bags into the boot, cars are coming in behind their car and we need to keep our little people as safe as possible.

We have asked all students to:

- wait along the fence, well away from the road. This keeps them as safe as we can and provides a clear walkway for students to walk home and to cars.
- walk to their car (come of the children run to be first arguing with their siblings over the front seat – our concern is as they run and argue they could fall into the path of an incoming car)
- wait with other students in the 'Kiss and Drop' zone if they are waiting to be picked up. We have had a number of situations where children have been called across the road by parents waiting in the 'No Stopping' area directly opposite the school. Staff will stop students running across the road to a waiting car.
- We ask that parents drive around the roundabout to collect their child from the 'Kiss and Drop' zone. At 3.30pm, any students waiting for a parent will walk to the office with one of our staff. This keeps the child safe and enables us to phone parents to ensure arrangement have been made to pick up their child.

Important Enrolment Information

The NSW Department of Education introduced a revised enrolment policy. This Enrolment Policy, implemented as of 22 July 2019, will have an impact on the manner in which we process non-local enrolments over coming years.

Each school has been allocated an enrolment cap based on classroom accommodation. At Dalmeny this calculation is based on 24 permanent rooms. Our school has increased in enrolments to the point where we have exceeded this allocated cap.

All students who reside within our local intake area will continue to be offered enrolment at Dalmeny Public School, however, as current enrolments are greatly in excess of our local enrolment cap, non-local enrolment applications can no longer be accepted.

The policy also stipulates that schools above the allocated enrolment cap must now use a prescribed 100 point check to verify that all students who present for enrolment reside within the designated intake area. This information is available from the office upon request.

Making Payments & Upcoming Excursions

Please forward all payments to the administration office, enclosed in an envelope that has your child's name, class, amount you are paying and what you are paying for marked clearly on the front.

EFTPOS facilities are available at the office between 8.30am and 2.15pm.
