Important Enrolment Information

The NSW Department of Education introduced a revised enrolment policy. This Enrolment Policy, implemented as of 22 July 2019, will have an impact on the manner in which we process non-local enrolments over coming years.

Each school has been allocated an enrolment cap based on classroom accommodation. At Dalmeny this calculation is based on 24 permanent rooms. Our school has increased in enrolments to the point where we have exceeded this allocated cap.

All students who reside within our local intake area will continue to be offered enrolment at Dalmeny Public School, however, as current enrolments are greatly in excess of our local enrolment cap, NON-LOCAL ENROLMENT APPLICATIONS CAN NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED. ALSO ANY OUT OF AREA SIBLINGS

WILL NOT BE ABLE TO BE ACCEPTED FROM TERM 4 THIS YEAR.

The policy also stipulates that schools above the allocated enrolment cap must now use a prescribed 100 point check to verify that all students who present for enrolment reside within the designated intake area. This information is available from the office upon request.

If you have a child turning 5 before 31 July, 2020, we are accepting enrolments for Kindergarten.
